

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2. Structure of FRP

This RFP document for Selection of Agency for Supply and Training of Sniffer/ Tracker Dog for Use in Similipal Tiger Reserve, Baripada, Mayurbhanj, Odisha comprises of the following areas:

The bidder is expected to respond to the requirements as completely and in as much relevant detail as possible and focus on demonstrating bidder's suitability to become the Implementing agency for this project.

3. PROJECT BACKGROUND

The rising trend of Wildlife crime in the state of Odisha necessitates improvement of holistic infrastructure on crime detection and investigation. Procurement of sniffer/Tracker Dog in various Forest and Wildlife Division of Odisha will enhance the capabilities of the department in detection of the offender and contrabands which will further strengthen the efforts of wildlife protection. In the above context, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (WL) & Chief Wildlife Warden, Odisha has proposed for procurement of 10 nos. of Sniffer/ Tracker dog in 1st phase for 7 nos. wildlife & territorial division of the state.

Similipal South Wildlife Division is one such division which has been allowed for procurement of 2 nos. of sniffer/tracker dog for use them in detection of various wildlife crime through detection of wildlife articles and successful tracking of poacher movement in Similipal Tiger Reserve and in the adjoining divisions.

4. INSTRUCTIONS TO THE BIDDERS

4.1 Request for Proposal

- a. The Deputy Director, Similipal South Wildlife Division hereinafter called as "Authority" invites sealed proposals from eligible bidders for "Supply and Training of Sniffer/ Tracker Dog for Use in Similipal Tiger Reserve, Baripada, Mayurbhanj, Odisha" as per detailed scope of work in this RFP document.


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- b. This invitation to bid is open to all bidders meeting the minimum eligibility criteria as mentioned in this RFP Document.
- c. Not more than one bid shall be submitted by one Bidder.
- d. Proposals must be received not later than time, date and venue mentioned in the Fact Sheet. Proposals that are received late will not be considered in this procurement process.
- e. Bidder who has downloaded the RFP from the official website: (www.similipal.org) shall not tamper/modify the RFP form including downloaded price bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tampered /modified in any manner, bid will be completely rejected and EMD would be forfeited and Bidder is liable to be banned from doing business with the authority.
- f. The authority will award the contract to the successful bidder whose proposal has been determined as the best value proposal based on Technical and Financial evaluation criteria and accepted by the Tender Accepting Authority.
- g. The authority reserves the right to reject any or all the Bids in whole or part, prior to signing of the Contract, without assigning any reasons.

4.2 General Instructions

- a. All information supplied by Bidders may be treated as contractually binding on the Bidders, on successful award of the assignment by the "Authority" on the basis of this RFP.
- b. No commitment of any kind, contractual or otherwise shall exist unless and until a formal written contract has been executed by or on behalf of the "Authority". Any notification of preferred Bidder status by the "Authority" shall not give rise to any enforceable rights by the Bidder. The "Authority" may cancel this public procurement at any time prior to a formal written contract being executed by or on behalf of the "Authority".
- c. This RFP supersedes and replaces any previous public documentation and communications, and Bidders should place no reliance and dependence on such communications.

4.3 Compliant Proposals/ Completeness of Response

- a. Bidders are advised to study all instructions, forms, terms, requirements and other information in the RFP documents carefully. Submission of the bid shall be deemed to have been done after careful study and examination of the RFP document with full understanding of its implications.
- b. Failure to comply with the requirements of this paragraph may render the Proposal non-compliant and the Proposal may be rejected. Bidders must:


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- Include all documentation specified in this RFP.
- Follow the format of this RFP and respond to each element in the order as set out in this RFP.
- Comply with all requirements as set out within this RFP.

5. KEY REQUIREMENTS OF THE BID

5.1 General requirement

5.1.1 Earnest Money Deposit

- a. An EMD of the value @ ₹50,000/- must be paid through Demand Draft/Cheque in favour of the Deputy Director, Similipal South Wildlife Division, Bhanjpur, Baripada in any nationalized Bank payable at Baripada.
- b. The EMD should be submitted in the Technical Bid.
- c. The EMD of the unsuccessful bidders would be returned on the same day of the final selection of bidder.
- d. The EMD of successful bidder would be returned after expiry of Warranty Period.
- e. The bid / proposal submitted without EMD, mentioned above, will be summarily rejected.
- f. The EMD shall be forfeited:
 - If Bid is withdrawn during the validity period or any extension agreed by the Bidder thereof.
 - If the Bid is varied or modified in a manner not acceptable to the Purchaser after opening of Bid during the validity period or any extension thereof.
 - If the Bidder tries to influence the evaluation process.
 - If the successful bidder fails to sign the contract or the performance guarantee is not submitted within the time specified
- g. The local MSE bidders are exempted from submission of EMD. However, they must furnish documentary evidence against the same.

5.1.2 Tender Paper Cost

The participating bidders shall submit a non-refundable tender paper cost of ₹5,000/- (Five Thousand) through Demand Draft/Cheque in favour of Deputy Director, Similipal South Wildlife Division, Bhanjpur, Baripada in any nationalized Bank payable at Baripada.

5.2 Bidder Eligibility

- 5.2.1 Experience:** The participant agency/bidder shall have at least 10 years of experience in supplying trained sniffer/Tracker dog with adequate facilities of training of dogs and provide services in all India basis.
- 5.2.2 Supply History:** The bidder/vendor/supplying agency shall have history of supply to central/state government department preferably Army, Police, Excise and Forests


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department. The bidder/agency shall be asked to submit the authentic supply certificate/ Purchase Order to this effect while submitting the Bid or EOI.

5.2.3 Training Expertise: The bidder/vendor/supplying agency shall have experience in training handlers of government agencies in India or abroad.

5.2.4 Financial Stability: The agency/vendor must have minimum turnover of Rs.1 crore every year in the last 3 years.

5.3 Technical Requirement

5.3.1 Selection of Breed and Age

1. Breeds: The breed shall be of Belgian Malinois with known pedigree.
2. Age: Age must be between 12 months to 18 months.

5.3.2 Registration of Dog

1. Registration: All dogs must be registered with the Kennel Club of India (KCI) or a similar recognized body in India.
2. An original certificate with known pedigree of at least three generations should be provided and matching microchip shall be implanted in the dog.
3. The certificate should mandatorily mention the date of birth, microchip number, and breed name.

5.3.3 Capabilities

1. Wildlife Protection: The dog should be trained in scent detection to identify and track wildlife, including injured or trapped animals, within the Forest/reserve.
2. Contraband Detection: The dog should be trained to detect wildlife contraband like RBT Skin, Leopard Skin, Elephant Tusks, Wild meat, gun, explosive, snares, electric wires set for electrocution of wild animals, poison used to kill wild animals and crude bombs and any other item as desired by the department.
3. Poacher Tracking: The dog shall be able to track poachers by following their walking trail.

5.3.4 Additional requirement for Dogs

1. Identity: All dogs supplied must be implanted with an International Standard identity microchip.
2. General Health: All dogs must be in good physical condition and free from Heartworm and any other internal or external parasites. Documentation proving this must be provided.
3. Dentition: Dog should have sound dentition.


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4. Vaccination: All dogs supplied must be fully vaccinated for diseases including Rabies, Canine Distemper, Hepatitis, Enteritis, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus, Leptospirosis, Coronavirus, DHL, Kennel Cough etc.
5. Hip X-ray: Dogs must be hip x-rayed and proven to be free from any manifestations of Hip Dysplasia problems. A copy of the relevant x-ray plates, endorsed with the dog's microchip number by a veterinarian, must be supplied with each dog.
6. Eye Examination: Dogs must be free of retinal dysplasia and retinal folds.
7. Respiratory Examination: Dogs must be free from respiratory system birth defects upon clinical examination (e.g., Tetralogy of Fallot).
8. Cryptorchidism or monorchidism should not be present in Male dogs.

5.3.5 Delivery Condition

1. Pre-Delivery Inspection: After completion of training a representative from the "Authority" shall conduct a pre-delivery inspection at the vendor's location to ensure the dog meet the specified requirements.
2. The inspection shall be made by an in house veterinarian or a veterinarian called upon from department of Fisheries and Animal Resource Development Department, Govt. of Odisha by the "Authority". The representative shall asses the overall health of the dogs, performance and verify the relevant certificate before taking final delivery from the agency/vendor.
3. Medical Examination: The dogs will be delivered after passing a thorough medical examination conducted by the veterinarian sent by the "Authority". Any abnormalities/irregularities found in any individual during the examination will be rejected and the vendor shall replace the same with other individual which will pass the medical screening.
4. Delivery Period: The agency/Vendor shall supply the required number of dogs within 3 months from the date of placement of order.
5. Logistics: The "Authority" will make all required logistic arrangement while transportation of dogs from Vendor location to the intended location. The dog handler shall accompany the dog while transporting the dog. A veterinary doctor shall accompany enroute to avoid any health complicacy due to transportation fatigue. Sufficient food, medicine as prescribed by the veterinarian or agency shall be kept in stock with the transporting team while transporting the dogs.

5.3.6 Training of Dogs and Handler

1. Training of Dogs: Before delivery of the dogs, the dog shall be trained in all aspect to enhance their capacities to track the poacher, wildlife articles and of course the live wild animals in forest or outside forests. The training shall be made in the vendor facilities.
2. The training should be positive reward based.


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3. Competency Standard Assessment: All dogs must undergo a Competency Standard Assessment Test, set by internationally recognized bodies such as the International Search and Rescue Dog Organisation (IRO), National Search and Rescue Dog Association (NSARDA), or equivalent, and must have a certification of competency.
4. Handler Training: There shall be one Handler and Assistant Handler for each dog. The "Authority" will nominate one Forest Guard/ Forester for the Handler and one Daily Wage Watcher/Protection Assistant as Asst. Handler for the said purpose.
5. Training at Vendor Location: Selected personnel (Handler & Asst. handler) will undergo at least 2-week training program at the vendor's location to bond with and learn to handle the dogs.
6. Follow-Up Training: The vendor shall conduct a 2-week follow-up training session at the "Authority" location to ensure the dogs are acclimatized and operational within in the new environment. The later will arrange food, travel and accommodation for the trainer at his location.
7. Training equipment: One set of training equipment to be provided upon completion of training by the agency/vendor.
8. Menu Chart & Check list: Full menu chart and husbandry related check list to be provided by the agency/vendor during final handover.
9. At least one refresher training should be given at the place where dogs are working in every quarter for one year after delivery.

5.3.7 Warranty & replacement

1. The dogs must be warranted to be in good health and operational for at least one year. Any dogs that fails to meet operational standards due to health issues or other factors will be replaced at the vendor's expense within the warranty period.

6. SUBMISSION OF PROPOSAL

6.1 General Condition

The proposal shall be submitted in 2 parts i.e. Technical Bid (Part A) and Financial Bid (Part B) must be inserted in separate sealed envelopes, along with bidder's name and address in the left-hand bottom corner of the envelope and super scribed in the following manner.

Part-A: Technical bid for "**SUPPLY AND TRAINING OF SNIFFER/ TRACKER DOG FOR USE IN SIMILIPAL TIGER RESERVE, BARIPADA, MAYURBHANJ, ODISHA**"

Part-B: Financial bid for "**SUPPLY AND TRAINING OF SNIFFER/ TRACKER DOG FOR USE IN SIMILIPAL TIGER RESERVE, BARIPADA, MAYURBHANJ, ODISHA**"


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Both the envelopes i.e. envelope for Part-A and Envelope for Part-B must be packed in separate sealed outer covers and clearly super scribed with the following:

The Bidder's name & address shall be mentioned in the left-hand corner of the outer envelope. The inner and outer envelopes shall be addressed to the Deputy Director, Similipal South WL Division at the following address:

If the outer envelope and the financial bid envelope is not sealed and marked as mentioned above, then Deputy Director, Similipal South WL Division will assume no responsibility for the bid's misplacement or premature opening. Telex, cable or facsimile bids will be rejected.

The interested bidder can collect the detail document of the proposal (RFP) visiting in person at the office of the Deputy Director, Similipal South Wildlife Division located at Bhanjpur, Baripada, Odisha in any of the working days between 25.08.2024 to 09.09.2024 up to 1.00 P.M or can download the same in the official website of Similipal Tiger Reserve www.similipal.org between these date.

The bidder can submit the proposal in person visiting the office as mentioned above between the aforementioned working days or can submit the same in Post/Courier in the above address.

The Last date of receiving the tender is Last 09.08.2024 up to 1.00 P.M.



6.3 The following documents are to be submitted in the Financial Bid (Part B):

Financial Bid should be quoted in the prescribed format given in **Annexure-III**.

7. VALIDITY OF OFFER

The offer should be kept valid for a period of at least 120 days from the date of opening of tenders, failing which the tender will be rejected. However, validity of the price bid of selected bidder will be for entire contract period including extension period as mentioned in the RFP and the extension period, if any.


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The "Authority" reserves the rights to reject a proposal valid for a shorter period as non-responsive and will make the best efforts to finalize the selection process and award of the contract within the bid validity period.

8. ACCEPTANCE AND REJECTION OF BIDS

The "Authority" reserves the right to reject in full or part, any or all bids without assigning any reason thereof. The "Authority" reserves the right to assess the Bidder's capability and capacity. The decision of The "Authority" shall be final and binding. Bid should be free of overwriting. All measures, correction or addition must be clearly written both in words and figures and attested. Offers not submitted in prescribed manner or submitted after due date and time are liable to rejection.


9. EVALUATION PROCESS

- a. The Proposal Evaluation Committee constituted by the "Authority" shall evaluate the responses to RFP and all supporting documents/ documentary evidence. Inability to submit requisite supporting documents/ documentary evidence, may lead to rejection of the bid. The committee will include a veterinarian as a member.
- b. The decision of Proposal Evaluation Committee in evaluation of responses to the RFP shall be final. No correspondence will be entertained outside the process of negotiation/ discussion with the Committee.
- c. The Proposal Evaluation Committee reserves the right to reject any or all proposals on the basis of any deviations.
- e. Each of the responses shall be evaluated as per the criteria and requirements specified in this RFP.
- f. Clarification (if any) sought has to be submitted by the bidder within specified timeline, failing which the Bid is liable to be rejected.
- g. Technical Presentation: The shortlisted bidder/agency shall be allowed to present a technical presentation showing the organisation portfolio, facilities including infrastructure and past experience for appraisal of the committee.
- h. Final Selection: The final selection of the agency among the qualified bidder shall be made after technical presentation based on QCBS method (Quality cum Cost Based Selection).

9.1 Criteria for Evaluation

All bids will primarily be evaluated on the basis of Prequalification Criteria- Cum-Technical Bid. The Evaluation Committee will carry out a detailed evaluation of the Proposals.

The Pre-Qualification proposal shall be evaluated as per criteria mentioned below and only those bidders who qualify the requirements will be eligible for next set of evaluations.


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Technical Proposal of Bidders who do not meet the Pre-Qualification criteria will not be considered for financial evaluation.

9.3 Technical Evaluation Scoring Matrix

The technical score of all the bidders would be calculated as per the criteria mentioned below. All the bidders who achieve more than **70 marks** in the Technical Evaluation would be eligible for the next stage, i.e. Financial Bid opening.

9.4 Evaluation of Financial Bids

- The financial Bids of technically qualified bidders (i.e. Bidders with more than 70 marks in Technical Evaluation) will be opened on the same date in the presence of bidder representatives.
- Any conditional bid would be rejected.
- Errors & Rectification: Arithmetical errors will be rectified on the following basis: "If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and total price shall be corrected. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words will prevail. If the bidder does not accept the correction of error, its bid will be rejected".

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d. In the event that there are 2 or more bidders having the same value in financial bid, the bidder securing highest technical score will be adjudicated as "Best responsive bid" for award of the Contract.

e. The bidder with lowest qualifying financial bid (L1) will be awarded 100% score. Financial score for other bidders will be evaluated using the following formula:

$$F_n = \left\{ \left(\frac{\text{Financial Bid of L1}}{\text{Financial Bid of Bidder}} \right) * 100 \right\} \%$$

9.5 Final Evaluation of Bids

a. The technical and financial evaluation scores secured by each bidder will be added using weightages of 70% and 30% respectively to compute composite score. The composite score will be computed as under:

$$B_n = 70\% * T_n + 30\% * F_n$$

b. The bidder securing highest composite score will be adjudicated as most responsive bidder for award of contract.

c. In case of a tie between bidders, the bidder with the highest Technical Scores will be considered.

10. ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

10.1 Arbitration

In the event of any disputes arising out his contract, the same shall be referred for arbitration to the Deputy Director, Similipal South Wildlife Division or any arbitrator appointed by the tender inviting Authority after due notice of claim and such appointment and the award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding arbitration and conciliation Act, 1996 shall apply. The venue of arbitration will be Baripada.

All disputes shall be subject to jurisdiction of the Court in Baripada.

10.2 Force Majeure:

In no event shall either Party have any liability for failure to comply with this Agreement, if such failure results directly from the occurrence of any contingency beyond the reasonable control of the Party, including, without limitation, strike or other labour disturbance, riot, major power failure, war, natural calamities including but not limited to floods, earthquakes, fire, volcanic eruptions, epidemics, National Emergency, interference by any government or governmental agency, embargo, seizure, or enactment or abolition of any law, statute, ordinance, rule, or regulation (each a "Force Majeure Event").

In the event that either Party is unable to perform any of its obligations under this Agreement because of a Force Majeure Event, the Party who has been so affected shall as soon as may be, after coming to know of the Force Majeure Event, inform the other Party and shall take reasonable steps to resume performance as soon as may be after the cessation of the Force Majeure Event. If the period of non-performance due to a Force Majeure Event exceeds thirty (30) days, the Party whose ability to perform has been so affected may, by giving written notice, terminate this Agreement.
